Project Veritas on Wednesday released a video of a Pfizer executive admitting that Pfizer is internally discussing a way to "mutate" the COVID-19 virus via "directed evolution" in an effort to "preemptively develop new vaccines."

Project Veritas on Wednesday released a video of a Pfizer executive admitting that Pfizer is internally discussing a way to "mutate" the COVID-19 virus via "directed evolution" in an effort to "preemptively develop new vaccines."

The executive, Jordon Trishton Walker, is a "Pfizer Director of Research and Development, Strategic Operations — mRNA Scientific Planner," Project Veritas reported.

The video shows Walker telling an undercover Project Veritas journalist:

"One of the things we're exploring is like, why don't we just mutate it [COVID-19] ourselves so we could create — preemptively develop new vaccines, right?

"So, we have to do that. If we're gonna do that though, there's a risk of like, as you could imagine — no one wants to be having a pharma company mutating f**king viruses."




Walker referred to COVID-19 as a "cash cow" for Pfizer and admitted that there is "a revolving door for all government officials" that's "pretty good for the industry" but "bad for everyone else in America."

Dr. Robert Malone — who was asked by Project Veritas to provide expert comment on the footage

and who also appears in the 10-minute video — said Walker's comments showed the Pfizer executive "seemed to have no moral compass."

"Pfizer's research is dangerous, immoral and must be shut down now," Malone wrote in a Substack post, in which he included a full transcript of Project Veritas' interview with Walker.

Commenting on the news, Robert F. Kennedy, Jr., chairman and chief litigation counsel for Children's Health Defense, tweeted:



Internal documents verify Walker works for pfizer

Sasha Latypova, a former pharmaceutical industry executive with 25 years of experience in pharmaceutical research and development, addressed the video on Substack.

Latypova urged readers to not fall for a "militarized propaganda narrative" by falling into fearful thinking about pharmaceutical companies' capabilities to create deadly viruses because that is "the most important thing for the perpetrators of this global crime."

She said:

"The perpetrators desperately, at all cost, need you to believe that 'mutating viruses in a lab' achieves some scary result, that then can be 'leaked.' That anyone can do it, even a Ph.D. student in their garage. That our enemies are doing it and will 'release' a super scary bug any time now, unless the Government is 'prepared' by making a stockpile of 'predictive vaccines' that can be deployed in DAYS after a new scary virus is detected in China. Or Timbuktu."

James Lyons-Weiler, Ph.D., called the footage "infuriating" because "there is literally nothing new here, we knew this in early 2020 (myself, Judy Mikovits, others). Ongoing serial passage leading to a little 'directed evolution.' He thinks it's funny and says it's not something they would want to advertise."

Lyons-Weiler — president and CEO of the Institute for Pure and Applied Knowledge — added:

"The moratorium on gain-of-function research to make viruses more deadly must be reinstated."

John Leake, who with Dr. Peter McCullough co-authored "The Courage to Face COVID-19," said on Substack:

"It does seem incredible that a major corporation — one that has played a key role in perpetrating a global criminal fiasco — is staffed with an executive who seems to have been recruited at a frat party."

However, Leake said, "The Pfizer internal documents tweeted by James O'Keefe appear to be authentic."
